Chief Mechanical Engineer (HOD) – 1 post in the pay scale of ₹ 43200-66000 (IDA Pattern)
<b>Educational qualification: Essential:</b> (i) Degree or equivalent in Mechanical/Electrical/Electronics & Communication Engg./Naval Architecture from a recognized University/Institution or MOT I <sup>st</sup> Class Motor Certificate issued under Merchant Shipping Act, 1958.  The deputation is from the Officers holding analogous posts or Officers holding post of Dy. Chief Mechanical Engineer and equivalent posts in Mechanical & Electrical Engg. Deptt. in the scale of pay of ₹.32900-58000 (₹16000-20800 pre-revised) and above with 3 years regular service in the grade in Govt./PSUs/Autonomous Bodies will be eligible as per RR Annexure – I.  The selection is by merit for which the bench mark in overall grading in the ACRs will not be below “Very Good”.

6. Vigilance clearance from the concerned CVO in the prescribed format, enclosed at Annexure-III, duly filled in all respect and Administrative clearance from the Heads of the organisations, signed and stamped by the concerned.
7. Two latest passport size photographs (to insert/attach in a envelop).
8. The veracity of the university certificates and the recognition of the degree obtained by the applicant may be ensured and certified.
9. Certificate also to be given by the employer, as in the overleaf of the application format.
