SUB: WEATHER ADVISORY

- 1. Inward movement of all vessels will be suspended if wind speed is more than 25 knots
- 2. All vessels alongside shall be ready to move to sea with their main engines. Accordingly the vessels loading, discharging and lashing of cargo to be done to achieve the desired trim and stability.
- 3. All vessels of New Mangalore Port anchorage to pick up the anchor and stream away from new Mangalore Port anchorage and proceed to safer place. The decision of the master would be final.
- 4. All coast guard sea going vessels inside the harbour to move out to sea.
- 5. Equipments and Machineries at under construction areas to be secured.
- 6. Unloaders at all berths / mooring dolphins to be secured.
- 7. All loaders at berths to be secured.
- 8. Harbour mobile cranes at all the berths are to be secured.
- 9. Loading arms, gangway at all the berths to be secured.
- 10. All small crafts inside the harbour to be secured properly and tend to their mooring continuously.
- 11. All crafts of coast guard, customs and harbour crafts which are unable to move to sea should remain secured and stand by at main engine during cyclone.
