The candidates possessing the requisite qualifications and experience for engagement as Master Gr II on contract basis (as laid down in the succeeding pages) may attend the Walk-in-Interviews that will be conducted in the chamber of the Dy.Chairperson, New Mangalore Port Authority, located at Panambur, Mangalore, Karnataka – 575 010, between 3.00 PM and 04.00 PM from 10/06/2022 onwards till the vacancy is filled.

The candidates desirous of attending the Walk-in-Interviews in connection with engagement to the post of Master Gr II on contract basis shall note the following points for compliance :

1. At the time of attending the said Walk-in-Interviews, the candidates should be in possession of the duly filled up application form, the format of which is given at the end of the terms & conditions for engagement as Master Gr II on contract basis, all the original certificates pertaining to their qualifications and experience etc. along with 02 xerox copies each of the said certificates and 02 copies of their recent passport size photographs.
2. The candidates should report to the office of the Deputy Conservator, located at the 2nd floor (Room No. 212) of the Administrative Office Building, NMPA, Panambur, between 10.00 AM and 12.00 noon on the day of their attending the Walk-in-Interview, for verification of their documents.
3. Before attending the said interview, the candidates have to contact on



telephone No. 0824-2887265 between 10.00 AM and 05.00 PM on all working days for queries, if any, regarding nature of work etc., and may inform about their attending the Walk-in-Interviews.

4. Results of the Walk-in-Interviews attended by the candidates will be made known only after completion of the entire period of Walk-in-Interviews (including the extended period of the Walk-in-Interviews, if any).

The Management reserves the right to:

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE POST OF
MASTER GRADE II ON CONTRACT BASIS.**

I. Qualification & Age: The candidate shall possess the following qualifications:

- a. Certificate Inland Master First Class granted under the Inland Vessels Act.
- b. Working experience of minimum 3 years in vessels of more than 2400 KW
Candidates having port service experience will be preferred.

- c. Age of the candidate should not be more than 50 years at the time of joining the service.

II Working Timings: The duration of working hours for the Master Gr II on contract basis will be 08 hours per day with one day weekly off in 7 days. He has to work onboard tugs in shift duties in accordance with the instructions and directions of the Deputy Conservator, NMPA. If duty is performed beyond 8 hours or on weekly off days, he would be entitled for overtime payment as applicable to NMPA staff.

III Monthly Remuneration:

(a) The consolidated pay for Master Gr II on contract basis is Rs.56,000. In case of availing port quarters, License fee, water charges and electricity charges as applicable would be deducted.

b) An annual increment of 5% may be considered after completion of every year.

IV Leave entitlement: He is entitled for 20 days Casual Leave per year at the rate of 05 days Casual Leave for every 03 completed months of service to the Master Gr II on contract. The non-availed casual leave can be carried forward to the following year. However, the casual leave cannot be accumulated more than 20 days.

If he avails himself of leave in excess of his casual leave entitlement or absents himself from duty without leave on any day, deduction of a sum proportionate to the period of such absence will be made from the total monthly remuneration payable to him by calculating on the basis of the said monthly remuneration divided by 30 for



each day of such absence.

V. Medical Facility: Entailed for free In house medical treatment in the NMPA Hospital for self, spouse and children to the extent the facilities are available in the Port hospital.

VI. Tenure of the Engagement: The tenure of the engagement shall be for a period of 03 years from the date of joining the duty/service.

VII. Security Bond: He shall execute a security bond (in the specimen attached herewith) to the effect that he will serve in the NMPA as a Master Gr II on contract basis for a period of 03 years from the date of joining the duty /service.

VIII. TA/DA for Tour Travel: As and when required to be deputed on official tour for the purpose of work, he will be entailed to draw TA/DA as applicable to the category of the post held by him, with prior approval of the Chairman on each occasion, obtainable through Deputy Conservator, New Mangalore Port Authority. However, whenever he is deployed to proceed on voyage by floating crafts to perform temporary duties at a place away from this Port's limits, he will be entitled to draw Voyage Allowance and Outstation Allowance at the applicable rates, in lieu of TA/DA. He will be entitled to draw the Voyage Allowances and Outstation Allowances with the prior approval of the Chairman on each occasion, obtainable through the Deputy Conservator, New Mangalore Port Authority. No TA/DA will be paid for joining for duty in response to this offer.

IX. Accommodation: He will be permitted to occupy the Port Quarters if he opts for the same. The class of accommodation that would be allotted to him shall commensurate with the post held by him subject to availability of vacant quarters. However, proportionate deductions will be made from the monthly consolidated salary payable to him as mentioned herein before. In addition, allied charges such as the license fee, water charges and electricity charges will have to be borne by the occupant.

X. Other Service Benefits: For the purpose of attributability for the injuries



sustained by him during his course of duty, the Master Gr II on contract basis will be treated as an employee of the New Mangalore Port Authority only during his duty hours.

XI. Termination of Contract: NMPA reserves the right to terminate the contract at any point of time at the discretion of port.

XII. Claim for permanent absorption: The contract engagement shall not confer on him any right to lay claim to permanent absorption in the port service against any post whatsoever.

XIII. Settlement of Disputes: In the event of any dispute arising out of this contract, the interpretation and decision of the Chairman, New Mangalore Port Authority will be final and binding.

If the candidate is amenable to the terms and conditions set out above, he/she will be required to execute a security bond in the format given herewith for the period of engagement as a Master Gr II on Contract basis and join for duty on the stipulated date. On the other hand, if he/she is not in a position to join for duty by the said date, he/she must send necessary communications duly intimating the date by which he/she will be able to join for duty as Master Gr II on contract basis at this Port. If he/she fails to comply with both the options, this offer will stand cancelled.

In addition to the above, the contract Master Gr II must take note of the fact that his/her engagement to the post of Master Gr II on contract basis shall be subject to his being medically fit for the duties to be performed in the said post. Therefore, the candidate selected for engagement as Master Gr II on contract basis will, at the first instance, have to report to the Chief Medical Officer of the New Mangalore Port Authority Hospital to undergo necessary medical examinations prior to joining duty as Master Gr II on contract basis at this Port.
