Sub: Priority Berthing to all vessels carrying domestic Coal – Reg.

The Ministry of Ports, Shipping & Waterways vide letter No. PD-12019/17/2022-PD-IV dtd. 23.06.2022 has advised Major Ports to accord priority berthing to all vessels carrying domestic coal as the vessels carrying domestic coal through the Rail-Sea-Rail (RSR) route are facing delay in berthing at various Ports due to which power generating companies are not able to get cheaper domestic coal in time and as a result domestic coal stock at power plants is depleting.

Accordingly, priority berthing will be accorded to the vessels calling at this Port for shipment of domestic coal under the provision of note 7 of Section 2.2 of Chapter II of Scale of Rates of New Mangalore Port Authority for a period upto 22.10.2022.
