Dear Dr. Ranjan,

As you are aware, the Customs department has taken several measures for fostering an environment of Ease of Doing Business by way of faster clearances of goods.

- 2. As a part of this continuing initiative, the CBIC has optimized its risk management using Artificial Intelligence (AI) techniques to increase the facilitation levels of import cargo to 90% from the 15th July, 2021. This would result in more number of consignments getting cleared immediately on arrival, thereby paving way for delivery directly from the Port. This would substantially reduce the time and cost being borne currently by the importers.
