Sub: Procedure for granting permission to Stevedoring and Shore Handling agents to deploy their own equipment at berth for handling containers in case of breakdown of Port owned/hired equipments.

To facilitate smooth container handling operation inside the Port, the Board vide Resolution No.67/2020-21 dated 30-06-2020 has accorded approval for granting permission to the Port users for operating their private Reach Stackers during the non-availability of Port owned/ hired reach stackers due to break down or other reasons, for handling of containers at berth as per SOP at Annexure I & II.

Accordingly, the Port users may seek permission as per the SOP for deploying their private Reach Stackers for handling their containers at berth in the event of non-availability of Port owned/ hired Reach Stackers due to break down or other reasons.

Standard Operating Procedure for granting permission to the port users for operating their own equipment for handling of containers at berth during the non availability of port owned/hired reach stackers/hired SLT due to break down or shortage.

1. Availability and Allotment of port equipment

a. No. Of Port owned/hired Side Lift Truck: 01 No.

b. No. Of Port owned/hired Reach Stacker: 05 Nos.

- The Port Users shall submit application in one day advance in their letterhead seeking permission for deployment of their own private Reach Stacker for handling containers at berth.
- ATM (Op)/ATM Gr.1 (Op) shall endorse the application and forward to concerned AE(M)/AEE(M) with details of the working container vessels at the berth.
- Based on the recommendation/remarks of AE(M)/AEE(M) for allotment of reach stackers at berth, ATM (Op)/ATM Gr.1 (Op) shall permit port users to handle containers for a period of 24Hrs.
  - The permission shall be extended for further 24 Hrs based on the recommendation of AE(M)/AEE(M), if required by the port users.
  - 6. As soon as completion of the container vessel operation, the port users shall take out their Reach Stackers outside the custom bound area. However, if they desire to keep their Reach Stacker inside the customs bound area, the same shall be permitted at designated parking area at their own risk and cost, on monthly license fee basis as per SOR.
  - 7. In case, if the port users are found handling containers by their own Reach Stackers without prior permission of the port, no further permission will be granted to them for using their own private Reach Stacker and they will be informed to take out their Reach Stacker from the port custom bound area.
