A. Scope of Work:

- 1) Dismantling of 2 Nos. 100 NB exhaust MS Pipeline of Cummins Engine model KTA 1150 F1 of DED Monitor Pump by cutting at approx. 1 meter distance inside FPH No.1. Each 100NB exhaust pipeline to be dismantled shall consist of approximately 13 mtr. Length including 4 Nos. flange, 2 No. Bend & fasteners.
- 2) Shifting of the removed 2 Nos. 100 NB exhaust MS Pipeline to Control Tower area @ Berth No.10
- 3) Fabricate of 2 Nos. 100NB new MS exhaust pipeline (Class B) with suitable fittings & fasteners similar to the existing exhaust pipeline including supply of material.


- 4) Apply of two coat Painting of Heat Resistant Paint (Temp. resistance up to 600°C - Aluminium) for newly fabricated 2 Nos. 100NB MS exhaust pipeline with fittings.
- 5) Installation of newly fabricated 2 Nos. 100NB MS exhaust pipeline with fittings & fasteners.

Note: Necessary Scaffolding for carrying out the above work to be carried out by the Contractor.

B. Terms and conditions:

1. The rate quoted shall be inclusive of all taxes & duties excluding GST and the same is firm and final. The rate quoted shall be inclusive of all expenses such as labour cost, material cost required for completion of the work, transportation, consumables, tools & tackles and other incidental charges etc. GST as applicable shall be paid extra.
2. GST Certificate shall be enclosed along with the quotation. If GST certificate is not produced, the quotation shall not be considered for evaluation.
3. The rate quoted should be valid for at least 45 **days** from the due date of submission of offer.
4. The Tenderer may visit the work site and get acquainted himself with the site conditions, nature of work involved before quoting, taking prior appointment with the undersigned. Any assistance in this regard will be provided by the Department.
5. (i) The work shall be commenced within 15th day from the date of issue of work order. The time allowed for completion of work is 7 working days.
(ii) During of the Berthing of Oil Tankers at Oil Jetty, the permission for carrying out the Welding/Chipping/Hot Work will not be allowed. Number of days for the completion of the work will be counted the days of non occupancy of tankers in the Berth No.10(Tanker Jetty No.2).
6. **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:** In case of delay in completion of the work, liquidated damages (L.D) may be levied at the rate of 0.5% of the contract price plus applicable GST per week of delay, or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10 percent of the contract price.
7. The contractor is required to be equipped with manpower and materials, equipment, tools & tackles, consumables etc. required for carrying out the work at all time and commence the work within 24 Hrs. after the information is passed on to him regarding the free availability of Jetty.
8. The contractor shall obtain hot work permission from the competent authority of NMPA for carrying out the hot works. The copy of the same shall be given to AEE(M), OTM Sub Div. before commencing the works.
9. Free electricity and water supply will be given for the said works.
10. Power supply will be given to the Contractor on free of cost. Tapping of power from the source point of NMPT to the required location will have to be arranged by the Contractor at his cost conforming to IE Rules / Standards.
11. The welding electrode used for the work shall be of leading specified make of Esab, Ador, Advani etc. of IS standard and the same shall be shown to the AEE(M), OTM Sub Division before commencing the work.

12. The contractor shall be responsible for taking precautionary measures for the safety of the work men working under him and the responsibility arising due to any mishap during the execution of work, the payment of compensation, if any, lies entirely on the part of the Contractor. The Contractor has to employ skilled and competent workers for carrying out the work. The workmen shall have insurance cover during the course of execution of work.
13. Any damages to the departmental properties during the execution of works will be on contractors account.
14. The free wharf entry passes to the personnel (Red Pass) shall be provided by the Department as per the Rules. The required documents for the same shall be provided by the Contractor well in advance.
15. The work will be carried out to the entire satisfaction of Engineer in charge of the Department .
16. No advance payment will be made but 97% of Payment with 100% GST will be made within 15 days after successful commissioning of the job and submitting of bill induplicate to the undersigned. Balance 3% payment will be withheld till the completion of Guarantee period of 6 months and the same shall be release without interest after completion of Guarantee period.
17. The work carried out shall be guaranteed for a period of Six months from the date of satisfactory completion of the work.
18. Statutory taxes as applicable will be deducted while releasing payment.
19. The acceptance of the Quotations rests with the competent authority of NMPT who does not bind himself to accept the lowest Tender and reserves to himself the authority to reject any or all the Tenders received without assigning any reason.
20. The Competitive offer enclosed in a sealed cover super scribed as "Dismantling of existing corroded Exhaust Pipeline Connected to Cummins Engines coupled to Fire water Monitor Pump at FPH No.1 of Berth No.10 and Fabrication & Erection of new Exhaust Pipeline" should reach to the under signed on or before 25/07/2022 at 15:00 Hrs. to the below mentioned address. Quotation will be opened on the same day at 4.00 PM in the presence of the bidders who wish to be present.
