| Point 10 states that the NIO Approval should be valid for 5 years at the time of delivery. Please be guided, the NIO Approval is Valid for 5 years from the date of the issue of approval by The NIO, Goa & not from date of the particular lot supply. To get 5 years NIO approval validity from date of supply, that particular Lot will have to be tested by the NIO, Goa at their Goa Lab under stimulated conditions which costs upwards of Rs4.5lacs + GST & takes 2 to 3 months from submission of OSD Sample along with BHCO sample. For this RFQ qty is only 1000ltrs & not viable. | Clarification: Particular lot supply of OSD shall be tested by NIO, GOA and for the same test certificate of NIO, GOA shall be submitted and shall be valid at time of delivery. The supplier has to submit an undertaking for shelf life(storage life) of the OSD, which shall be valid for minimum 5 years from date of delivery. |
| Point no 14 states the OSD should have ≥ 10000 ppm Toxicity, though the ICG 2009 Guidelines states moderately to slightly toxic are permission (≥ 100 ppm to ≤ 10000 ppm).To the best of our Knowledge, none of the existing OSD supplied in India & having a VALID NIO Approval has achieved this results of ≥ 10000 ppm.Only one OSD product had achieved this results but their NIO approval of 10th Feb 2010 has | Clarification: Other than the said OSD toxicity limit, it is also accepted to provide toxicity limit moderately to slightly as per ICG 2009 Guidelines. |
