1 Clause No. 2 of GCC to read as:

COMMENCEMENT OF CONTRACT

The successful bidder shall commence the work within 120 days from the date of issue of Work Order.

2 Clause No. 37 of GCC to read as:

At the time of submission of bids, the BOATS offered by the bidder in Annexure -7 should be either of the following:

A IN CASE BIDDER INTENDS TO SUPPLY BOATS OWNED BY THE BIDDER

Bidder should submit the following along with **Technical bid**:

- i. Technical details of boats as in Annexure 7
- ii. Fuel Consumption of boats as in Annexure 8
- iii. Valid Class Certificate (IACS)
- iv. Boat Registration Certificate
- v. Boat GA Plan

The **owned boats** shall be deployed within **120 days** from the date of issue of Work Order, failing which penalty will be imposed as per Clause No. **50(A)** of GCC up to period of **60 days** (penalty period). After completion of **60 days** of penalty period, the contract shall liable to be terminated and the EMD / Performance Security will be forfeited.

B IN CASE BIDDER INTENDS TO SUPPLY NEW BUILT BOATS CONSTRUCTION IN INDIA (As per Make in India Policy)

Bidder should submit the following along with **Technical bid**:

- i. An undertaking of new built boats as in Annexure 11
- ii. Technical details of new built boats as in Annexure 7
- iii. Fuel Consumption of new built boats as in Annexure 8

However, the successful bidder shall submit MOU / Agreement for New Built boats in a non-judicial stamp paper (₹100) between the bidder and the shipyard in India confirming arrangement for construction of boats meeting the specification within Twenty (20) working days from the date of issue of Work Order, failing which the same will be recorded in his service/completion certificate.

If the successful bidder is providing new built boats, they will be allowed to provide alternative boats (**owned** / **hired**) as per the clause No. 36 of GCC **Boat requirements** or higher capacity for commencement of contract. The alternative boats shall be deployed within **120 days** from the date of issue of Work Order. The newly built boats as per the specification in **Annexure-7** shall be deployed within **180 days** from the date of issue of Work Order.

In case alternative boats are not deployed within 120 days from the date of issue of Work Order, penalty will be imposed as per Clause No. 50(A) of GCC. If the newly built boats are not deployed within 180 days from the date of issue of Work Order, Penalty will be imposed as per Clause No. 50 (B) of GCC.

However, alternative boats deployed by the contractor shall be permitted till the newly built boats are deployed for operation or maximum period of **240 days** (180 days from the date of issue of Work Order + 60 days penalty period) from the date of issue of Work Order. Any delay in delivery of the Boats by the owner or builder of the Boat or transshipment delays or any other reason excluding force majeure will not be accepted and penalty shall be imposed as mentioned above.

If the fuel consumption of the alternative boats exceeds the declared fuel oil consumption of offered boats as in **Annexure-8**, the Port would recover the cost towards the excess consumption of fuel from the monthly bill, as per fuel rates prevailing at that time.

- vii. Charter Hire Agreement from the concerned party from whom he intends to hire the boats as per the clause No. 36 of GCC Boat requirements. Charter Hire Agreement should be in a non-judicial stamp paper (₹100) duly signed by both the bidder and the concern party mentioning that the boats is hired exclusively for NMPA.

However, bidder shall submit MOU / Agreement for purchase (complying with Make in India policy of Govt. of India) from concerned party from whom he intends to own the boats as per the clause No. 36 of GCC Boat requirements in a non-judicial stamp paper (₹100) within Twenty (20) working days from the date of issue of Work Order, failing which the same will be recorded in his service/completion certificate.

Initially hired boats shall be deployed within 120 days from the date of issue of Work Order. However, the bidder should supply owned boats or own the initially hired boats within 180 days from the date of issue of Work Order and documentary evidence for the same to be submitted, failing which the contract shall liable to be terminated and the Performance Security will be forfeited.
