The Copies of Annual Turnover signed by CA with U DIN Number or Profit & Loss Account & Balance Sheet of the Last three Ye ars with UDIN Number must be submitted as Documentary Evidence.
- b) The Bidder should have experience in the field of "Supply of Batter ies" to any reputed Firms.

i. Copies of similar contract/supply order issued by the client for Proc urement of **Supply of Batteries** with duly self-attested shall be submi tted as documentary evidence.

ii. For the successfully completed contract, Bidder should have to s ubmit the copies of Supply Completion Certificate or Invoice or Delivery challan duly self-attested shall be submitted as supporting documentar y evidence.

- c) Offered Product Catalogue/Specification of the product to be submitted.
- d) **EMD**: The Bidder is required to pay Rs 14,250.00 Including GST (Item wise EM D Detailed in Bid Document) as EMD. The EMD may also be accepted in the form of Insurance surety bonds, account payee DD, Fixed deposit receipt, Ban kers cheque or Bank guarantee from any of the Commercial bank or Pay ment online in an acceptable form safeguarding the purchaser's interest i n all respects. RTGS receipt/evidence of EMD Credited shall be uploaded along with the Technical Bid. Failure in submission of EMD will render the Bidders disqualified,

EMD EXEMPTION: Exempted for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE) registered with MSME/NSIC are required to upload with their offer the pr oof of their being MSE registered with District Industries Centre (DIC) or K hadi and Village Industries Commission or Khadi & Industries Board (KVIB) or Coir Board or National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) or Director ate of Handicrafts and Handlooms or Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum or any other body specified by Ministry of MSME

Disclaimer

- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
