PROSPECTUS

The New Mangalore Port Trust English Medium School was established in the year 1978. The school was taken over by the Port Trust on 1-7-1983. The High School section was started in the year 1985. It caters mainly to the educational needs of the children of Port Trust employees and Dock Workers.

AIM:

Integral development to human person guided by the teaching and training.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. All round development of students intellectual, Physical, Psychological and Spiritual.
- 2. Solidarity as an institution without caste or communal prejudices.
- 3. Providing suitable opportunities for all to build up character, eschew evil habits and acquire a hatred for corruption and injustice.
- 4. To bring up as good Indian citizens who are morally upright guided by the right values and courageous to stand by their convictions.

MANAGEMENT:

The Management Committee constituted by New Mangalore Port Trust known as New Mangalore Port Trust Educational Society looks after the day to day management of the school.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION:

- 1. The Children who have completed 5 years 6 months of age on or before the date of re-opening of the school admitted to 1st standard regular admission basis.
- 2. Applications for admissions should be made in prescribed form which can be obtained from the office and should be submitted along with the Transfer Certificate from the school last attended. Every Pupil on admission shall pay the prescribed fees.
- 3. The admission application must be signed by father or mother or in their absence, by a guardian who has been authorised by the father to do so. The letter of authorisation must be filled with the admission form.
- 4. Admission to VIII Standard will be made on production of Transfer Certificate duly counter signed by the inspecting Officer in charge of the institution in strict conformity with the table of parity of standards issued by the Department.
- 5. Students who are found to have obtained admission by false representation or documents will be summarily dismissed with forfeiture of all fees.

6. Admission shall ordinarily be closed within a month from the re-opening of the school.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

- 1. The working days from Monday to Friday are divided into two sessions. The morning session extend from 9.15 a.m.-12.20 p.m. and afternoon session from 1.10 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Saturday 9.20 a.m. to 12.55 p.m.
- 2. Every pupil shall present for the morning prayer at 0.30 a.m. and for the study session at 9.10 p.m. No pupil should be found loitering about or idling away their time during the study hours.
- 3. Pupils are expected to be in time to the school. Late corners will be admitted to classes only with the permission of the Headmaster with entry in the register.

 4. No pupil is allowed to leave the school without the permission

of the Headmaster. Headmistress

- 5. Punctuality and regular attendance is insisted upon. Leave and absence from school even for a few period for attending marriage, funerals etc. must be applied previously in the calendar.
- 6. When a pupil has been absent from the school without leave for unforeseen reasons like illness he or she must on returning to the school, bring a note of excuse from his or her parent or guardian in the form supplied in the calendar. Should the absence exceed three days, leave note must be forwarded to the Headmaster. Headmistress.
- 7. Special note will be taken of absence without leave from an examination and the re-opening of classes after the holidays. In the case of illness a medical fitness certificate will be required.
- 8. Irregular attendance, insubordination to the teachers, habitual inattention to school work, obscenity in word or act are sufficient reasons for temporary or permanent dismissal of a class. Damaging school property etc. are punished by a fine.
- 9. The school does not hold itself responsible for the pupils conduct outside its premises. In justice however it takes cognisance of any serious misconduct of pupils committed outside be substantiated, the quality shall be punished according to the gravity of the offence.
- 10. Progress record will be issued after the tests and Mid-term examination. They shall be duly signed and returned to the class teacher by the parent or guardian at the earliest. In no case parent should return the progress cards without their signature. Parents are requested to meet the teacher when they are called upon with the permission of the Headmaster. Head mist rest
- 11. Students should wear the prescribed 'SCHOOL UNIFORMS' on all days.

- 12. No books, magazines, newspapers etc. not approved by the H.M. should be brought to the school, if they are found in the school premises, they will be confiscated and action will be taken against such students who brought them.
- 13. The properties belonging to the school such as games articles. charts, maps etc. should be handled and maintained very carefully. The games articles should not be used at any time other than during the games period. In case of damage the pupil responsible is to replace it.
- 14. Disturbing other classes, running, playing or shouting inside the school premises is not allowed. No student is permitted to enter other classes without permission.
- 15. Pupil should adhere the discipline of the school whole heartedly. They should follow the bells scrupulously particularly the bells given after the recess time both in the forenoon and afternoon. They should never leave the school premises in-between intervals.
- 16. The school has a Bul-Bul flock, Scouts, Yoga & Karate classes are also conducted.
- 17. Pupils are not expected to come before time for class, those who do so approved reasons must proceed at once to their respective elected study halls and devote the interval to study or be reading the the library.
- 18. On the teacher's arrival in his classroom, the pupils must rise and remain, standing till they are desired to sit, or till the teacher takes his seat. When the attendance roll is called, each one must rise and answer to his hame.
- 19. No pupil is allowed to leave the class room without the permission
- of his teacher or until the class is dismissed.

 20. In moving from one to another at the end of each period, care should be taken to be so quickly as possible and in silence. At the closing bell of each session, pupils may leave the class room only when the teacher has gone out first.
- 21. Every pupil must salute the members of the staff on the occasion of first meeting them for the day.
- 22. Books, umbrellas etc. should have a name or mark by which the owner can be easily known and all unclaimed property should be brought to the H.M.'s office.
- 23. Pupils must not join any clubs or societies or make any Head mishes being agement that would interfere with their studies, without Headmaster permission. They are not allowed to play any team in against the school.
 - 24. When prayer is said at the beginning and at the end of the class, all must stand and pray respectfully.
 - 25. Parents and guardians are ipso facto members of the Parent-Teachers Association of the school which aims at fostering closer relationship, mutual understanding and cooperation between home and school.
 - 26. All classes are provided with C.C. T.V. and monitored by H.M. Any indiscipline of pupils will attract punishment / fine.

FEE REGULATIONS

Fee shall be leviable at the time of admission in respect of all classes as here under:

- 1. a) In the case of pupils other than children of Port Employees and Dock Workers, monthly tuition fees as prescribed by the Education Department of the Government of Karnataka shall be levied.
 - For the children of Port Employees and Dock Workers no tuition fee shall be charged.
 - Other fees prescribed from time to time by the Education Department will be levied.
 - Fees once paid will not be refunded. The N.M.P.T. School Management Society's decision is final.

TO PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

- 1. Parents are requested to co-operate with the school authorities in mattars of discipline, regular hours of study at home work and regular attendance in their respective classes at school.
- 2. Parents are requested to meet the teachers on every Friday afternoon to enquire about the progress and conduct of the students under their charge. Under no circumstances should the parents enter the class room and meet individual teachers during class hours. If a situation warrants to contact the children by the parents, intimation to the Headmaster should be given to call the student. Headmistress
- 3. Parents are advised to provide bus passes instead of giving cash money to the children who are coming from distant places to prevent them temptation of misusing it.
- 4. Children should avoid wearing gold ornaments.
- 5. For promotion a pupil must have put in 75% attendance and must have regularly attended crafts, Fine arts, Physical training and games classes during the academic year.
- 6. The head of the institution shall have the power to condone shortage to attendance upto 15 percentage of the total number of working days.
- 7. Parents should encourage their children to take a full share in the Co-curricular and extra curricular activities of the class rooms during class hours.
- 8. Parents and Guardians are not allowed to enter any of the class rooms during the class hours.
